A chance for those interested in a career in general practice to meet the GPs of today.

Specifically, we have purposefully selected GPs with a variety of different interests and roles to reflect how varied a career in general practice can be. Think GPwSIs (GP with special interests e.g. dermatology, urology, family planning), management and leadership roles, academic and teaching, out of hours work, partners, salaried, locums, medical volunteering, repatriation, business consultancy etc.

We will have 6-10 GPs (reflecting the roles above, as well as a current GP trainee) who have kindly given their time to share with you the opportunities and roles that exist in general practice. This is a great networking opportunity, allowing you to ask questions about their careers, and how they got there! Furthermore, our GPs are willing to exchange details so that you may contact them after this event, should you wish to learn more about their roles.

Trainees will rotate around four GP speakers in small breakout rooms and spend 10-15 minutes with the GPs that most interest them. Afterwards, there will be an opportunity for all the GPs and attendees to get together and network over some food.

This event is primarily designed for Foundation trainees (FY1/FY2), but those from other disciplines whom are thinking about a career change into general practice are also very welcome.

Our event this year will be face to face; though we will endeavour to record some of the discussions with our GP speakers to circulate to those whom not join us on the night.
