#### Internal Medicine Training Year 3 (IMY3) Update – FAO All IMY2 trainees

The IMT training programme is designed to prepare trainees for the role of the medical registrar. There is a critical progression point at the end of the second year (IMY2) to ensure trainees have the required capabilities and are entrusted to 'step up' to the medical registrar role in IMY3. For most, trainees will be entrusted to manage the acute unselected take and manage the deteriorating patient with indirect supervision. For a few, this will be for a period of time in a supportive training environment with the supervising physician readily available.

Work has been ongoing across the Midlands region to develop training placements for the IMY3 training year and there will be a new preferencing/selection process in IMY2 to allocate trainees to IMY3 training placement from August 2021. The Midlands Region is split into East and West so the choice of IMY3 post preferences will be restricted to the same section of the region that your IMY2 post is currently based. Therefore, if you are based in the West you will only be eligible to preference West Midlands IMY3 placements and vice versa.

Further information on the preferencing/selection process will be circulated in <u>February 2021</u> to all current IMY2 trainees, this will provide details of actions required and deadlines which you will be required to meet.
