Thailand Public Health Research Fellowship (TPHR)

February 2023 for 12 months

About the Programme

The TPHR Programme recruits NHS doctors from across England who have completed their Foundation training (as a minimum), and who have an interest in public health and developing their leadership. Fellows will work in partnership with academic teams in Thai medical schools, universities, and hospitals, on projects that impact healthcare delivery and system strengthening. You will be supported by a UK-based mentor, and a project supervisor in the research partner organisation. A stipend is paid by the Thai partner for the duration of the programme. The first cohort will begin their Fellowships in February 2022, and so this recruitment is for the second cohort, who begin Fellowships in February 2023.

- Opportunity to work in a healthcare system that is different in resource and structure to the • NHS
- Improved cultural competence through working in partnership with peers overseas
- Improved resilience, professional satisfaction, and a personal growth, that add value to your team and your patients on return to the NHS

Model of Fellowships

This Fellowship is a 12-month overseas placement with a partner organisation in Thailand. Variations to this model will only be possible in exceptional circumstances.

Recruitment for TPHR Fellowships will open on 1 December 2021 and will close on 10 January 2022. Shortlisted candidates will be invited to a virtual 30-minute interview between 26-31 January 2022.
