Typical working pattern in this placement	 9.30am to 5.00pm with appropriate break-times in between and protected teaching times during normal sexual health clinic cover. 2 week blocks of on-calls during medical on-takes. (Either 2 weeks of Monday to Thursday, or 2 weeks of Friday to Sunday [if one was doing day shifts during weekends, one will resume normal ward/clinic duties on following Monday] – variable hours during each shift, ranging from 10 hours to 12.5 hours).
