The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	<p>All F1 Doctors in hospital posts will generally be ward-based during the 'normal' working day and expected to deliver the daily medical care of all the patients on their ward, irrespective of specialty.</p> <p>The majority of the F1's time will be spent looking after the cardiology team's inpatient following emergency admissions. there will also be a number of elective admissions which are admitted to the cardiac ward for cardiology procedures such as coronary angiography and permanent pacemaker implantation. The post gives excellent exposure and experience in managing complex and sometimes critically/terminally ill cardiology patients. You will be involved in multidisciplinary teamwork and liaise with cardiac nurse specialists, heart failure nurses, nurses on the ward, cardiac physiologists, dieticians, physiotherapists and secretarial staff</p>

Main duties of the placement	<p>The F1 doctor is responsible, with other staff, for the ward care of patients and the maintenance of the patient's medical record.</p> <p>They are required to attend MDTs.</p> <p>They are required to attend F1 generic teaching programme (protected). In addition, there is a regular department educational meeting.</p> <p>They manage day-to-day ward problems with consultant, SpR and specialty doctor supervision</p> <p>They are involved in medical on-calls and ward cover</p>
