Main duties of the placement	<p>The FY1s are responsible for the initial assessment and admission of acute medical admissions on take days and will continue to be responsible for their ongoing care while in hospital.</p> <p>Patients are admitted from clinic or directly from the community.</p> <p>The FY1 has a CT/ST or Registrar available for immediate assistance. Duties during on-call will include seeing emergency admissions on the AMU</p>
Typical working pattern in this placement	The FY1s will take part in the medical on-call rota to include twilights, day on calls and nights
Employer information	<p>Please note that due to Trust reconfiguration our posts may change hospital site/specialty/on-call frequency during 2017/2018.</p> <p>Shrewsbury and Telford Hospital NHS Trust was formed in 2003 and is the main provider of acute medical care for half a million people in Shropshire, Telford & Wrekin and Mid Wales.</p> <p>Most services are provided at the Princess Royal Hospital in Telford and the Royal Shrewsbury Hospital in Shrewsbury.</p>
