The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	<p>Educational activity within all departments is very active and this takes place both formally and informally at Outpatients and Operating Theatre Lists.</p> <p>The work within these departments is relevant to both general practice and other hospital specialties.</p> <p>Participation in audit, Journal Club and X-ray meetings is normally expected at all levels.</p> <p>FY1 teaching takes place cross-site every week from 2.30pm to 5pm (bleep-free unless on call).</p> <p>FY1s are also required to attend Simulation Training during their FY1 year. Some opportunities to teach medical students.</p>
