The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	 Working within multi-disciplinary cardiology team to provide daily care to patients in specialty ward (including CCU). On-call G(I)M and G(I)M ward cover. Weekly medical Grand Round. Some opportunities to teach medical students. FY1 teaching takes place cross-site every week from 2.30pm to 5pm (bleep-free unless on-call). FY1s are also required to attend Simulation Training during their FY1 year.

Main duties of the placement	Specialty ward working and G(I)M on-call
