Main duties of the placement	<ul> <li>Daily Ward round.</li> <li>Looking after ward patients.</li> <li>Attend ward MDT meetings with nurses, physio, OT etc.</li> <li>Liaising with other teams involved in patient care.</li> <li>On calls covering either A&amp;E or out of hours cover for the wards or MAU.</li> <li>Attending clinics if desired by trainee</li> </ul>
Typical working pattern in this placement	9am ward rounds every day with consultant/SpR Ward jobs attending MDT reviewing patients on other wards, Trainees will be expected to cover the medical on-call rota.

Shrewsbury and Telford Hospital NHS Trust was formed in 2003 and is the main provider of acute medical care for half a million people in Shropshire, Telford & Wrekin and Mid Wales.
