The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	 Consultant Ward rounds Multi-disciplinary W/R Informal bedside teaching SHO/SpR Clinic and endoscopy attendance if time. FY1 teaching takes place cross-site every week from 2.30pm to 5pm (bleep-free unless on call). FY1s are also required to attend Simulation Training during their FY1 year.

Supervisor(s) for the placement	Dr Maxton
Main duties of the placement	The FY1s will help with the management of Gastro patients on the ward and trainees will also be responsible for the initial assessment of acute medical patients during on-calls. With the advice of the Specialist Registrar and STs, the FY1 will be concerned with the immediate management of a wide range of medical problems (acute and non-acute) and will look after patients admitted whilst on-call. All specialities have their own ward base.
Typical working pattern in this placement	Full shift as part of acute medical on-call covering nights, twilights, normal days etc.
Employer information	Please note that due to Trust reconfiguration our posts may change hospital site/specialty/on-call frequency during 2017/2018. Shrewsbury and Telford Hospital NHS Trust was formed in 2003 and is the main provider of acute medical care for half a million people in Shropshire, Telford & Wrekin and Mid Wales. Most services are provided at the Princess Royal Hospital in Telford and the Royal Shrewsbury Hospital in Shrewsbury.
