FY1s are also required to attend Simulation Training during their FY1 year.

Main duties of the placement	General ward management of respiratory and general medical inpatients, Consultant presence on ward every day.
Typical working pattern in this placement	9.00 arrive for board round. Ward round in the morning, usually with Consultant or SpR. Afternoon - general management of patients on the ward, and to undertake jobs generated by morning ward round. Finish at 5.00pm. Trainees take part in the general medical on-call rota.
