The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	 Assisting with the Consultant led CDU ward round and completion of tasks relevant to patient care Seeing patients de novo in all areas of the Emergency Department ensuring completion of patient care episodes. Being part of a team delivering patient care in the critical care setting. FY1 teaching takes place cross site every week from 2.30pm to 5pm (bleep free unless on-call). FY1s are also required to attend Simulation Training during their FY1 year.

Main duties of the placement	Consultant based teaching on the CDU ward round Every patient seen de novo requires to be discussed with a senior doctor which provides learning. Every radiological investigation ordered will be reviewed by a senior doctor during the review (as above). Being involved a team caring for critically unwell patients, allows exposure and education on recognition, investigation and treatment of the critically unwell patient In house teaching every week. Guaranteed release to FY1 teaching
Typical working pattern in this placement	There are no on calls and the post is unbanded.
