<b>Main duties of the placement</b>	<p>Consultant based teaching on the CDU ward round Every patient seen de novo requires to be discussed with a senior doctor which provides learning.</p> <p>Every radiological investigation ordered will be reviewed by a senior doctor during the review (as above).</p> <p>Being involved a team caring for critically unwell patients, allows exposure and education on recognition, investigation and treatment of the critically unwell patient In house teaching every week.</p> <p>Guaranteed release to FY1 teaching</p>
