<b>Main duties of the placement</b>	<p>This post offers time working in Cardiology.</p> <p>Daily admissions – clerking, assessment and instigation of initial treatment.</p> <p>Supervision of the FY1 as required. Shared supervision of the FY1's work, and providing teaching when possible. Some clerking duties and assisting the FY1 in ward duties.</p> <p>Attendance at ward rounds form an essential part of the work.</p> <p>Administrative duties include preparation of discharge summaries and communication with General Practitioners concerning in-patients.</p>
