Main duties of the placement	 This post offers time working in Cardiology. Daily admissions – clerking, assessment and instigation of initial treatment. Supervision of the FY1 as required. Shared supervision of the FY1's work, and providing teaching when possible. Some clerking duties and assisting the FY1 in ward duties. Attendance at ward rounds form an essential part of the work. Administrative duties include preparation of discharge summaries and communication with General Practitioners concerning in-patients.
