Ludlow, Oswestry, Shrewsbury, Market Drayton, Wellington, Alveley, Bridgnorth, Doddington). Some Practices have repsponibilites for patients in Community Hospitals and Minor Injury Units.

Main duties of the placement	A four month placement in General Practice, during which FY2 doctors will see patients in both routine and urgent appointments.

	The FY2 doctor will be supervised throughout the placement by an experienced GP.
	Administrative tasks in relation to patients they have seen, including referrals.
	The aim of the placement is to enhance knowledge of Primary Care and increase ability to recognise and manage common medical conditions.
Typical working pattern in this placement	40 hours per week, Normal working days. No on calls or weekends
