This may include visiting patients at home.</p> <p>The FY2 doctor will be supervised throughout the placement by an experienced GP.</p> <p>Administrative tasks in relation to patients they have seen, including referrals.</p> <p>The aim of the placement is to enhance knowledge of Primary Care and increase ability to recognise and manage common medical conditions.</p>
