Main duties of the placement	Contributing to the Multidisciplinary Care of Forensic Patients with serious mental illness. Learning opportunities within the service around assessing and treating serious mental illness, delivering aspects of physical healthcare, violence risk assessment and management, and audit and management activities. Within the Trust their are opportunities to shadow Clinicians in there services or to attend ward rounds in specialist services e.g. Mother and Baby Unit, Forensic Liaison, Court Diversion, Eating Disorders etc.
Typical working pattern in this placement	<ul> <li>First line assessment of mental and physical health problems with liaison and referral to other services as appropriate.</li> <li>Admission of new patients and regular mental state examinations and reviews of ward patients.</li> <li>Attendance at the weekly multidisciplinary review meetings (ward rounds) and the preparation of CPA (6monthly) reports.</li> <li>The preparation of admission and discharge summaries, although the admissions and discharges are infrequent - on average less than 1 admission a month.</li> </ul>
