Individual Placement Description - Shrewsbury and Telford Hospital NHS Trust

Placement	FY2 Neonatal Medicine
The department	Neonatal Medicine
The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	The trainee will gain broad exposure to a variety of problems in Neonatal Medicine ranging from well term neonates to extremely preterm infants.  Foundation training takes place weekly from 2.30pm - 5.00pm and Foundation Year 2 trainees are encouraged to attend a Simulation Training slot throughout the year.
Where the placement is based	Princess Royal Hospital
Supervisor(s) for the placement	Dr Tyler
Main duties of the placement	The trainee will be an integral part of a Multidisciplinary Team consisting of Paediatric ST1 to 3 trainees and Advanced Neonatal Nurse Practitioners.  The trainee will be fully supervised by Neonatal Specialty Registrars and Neonatal Consultants. The trainee will work in a variety of settings including Neonatal Intensive Care Unit, Postnatal wards and Outpatient clinics.
Typical working pattern in this placement	The trainee will initially spend time on the Neonatal Unit (sick babies) and Postnatal wards (well babies) during the daytime.  Out-of-hours work will be introduced in a graded fashion after gaining sufficient daytime experience during the first 6 - 8 weeks into the post, and will be supervised at all times.  Out of hours rota is shared between 4 doctors and Nurse Practitioners.
