Main duties of the placement	Outpatients attendance as agreed. Maintenance of the Acute Referral Clinic. Care of patients on the wards. Attendance on ward rounds. Theatre Sessions as agreed. Carrying out minor operative procedures. Attendance at the weekly Friday afternoon education session
Typical working pattern in this placement	Trainees will work a full shift rota to include evening, nights and weekend on-calls. Due to reconfiguration of services ENT and T&O Juniors work a combined rota and are required to cross cover both specialities
