The department	Renal
The type of work to expect and learning	The doctor will be working in a District General Hospital that has unselected Acute Medical Admissions, including hyperacute stroke.
opportunities	They will therefore receive excellent experience in general medicine. Through working on a Nephrology and General Medicine ward and being supervised by a Nephrologist the doctor will gain experience in the management of acute and chronic renal disorders.
	There will also be opportunities to gain experience in the management of patients on the chronic dialysis programme, dialysed at the Princess Royal Hospital, and acute indications for renal biopsy and haemodialysis. Foundation training takes place weekly from 2.30pm - 5.00pm and Foundation Year 2 trainees are encouraged to attend a Simulation Training slot throughout the year.

Main duties of the placement	The main duties will be that of supporting the management of patients on Ward 7 and outliers under the care of the Nephrologists. The total number will be around 20 patients and are seen each day.
	Contribution to the general medical on call rota which includes acute medical admissions as well as ward cover, though as part of a wider medical team that includes Consultants, Junior Doctors and Nurse Practitioners.
Typical working pattern in this placement	Trainees will be required to cover a number of duties to include, out of hours, on- calls, nights and twilights
