You will attend Monday Respiratory x-ray meetings and the General Medicine departmental meeting and teaching programme. Foundation training takes place weekly from 2.30pm - 5.00pm and Foundation Year 2 trainees are encouraged to attend a Simulation Training slot throughout the year.</p>  |
