The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	Excellent opportunity to acquire wide experience in basics of stroke medicine including hyper acute, acute, rehab and prevention. This includes daily ward rounds supervised and unsupervised with direct support from stroke consultants in County Hospital, attending specialised clinics such as TIA clinics in County Hospital and attending hyper acute stroke take with stroke consultants at Stoke. This placement also includes regular acute medical on-calls of unselected take. The trainee will be encouraged to take part in audit and presentations. During this posting trainee will be equipped with managing acute stroke patients and its physical complications as well as interpretation of imaging including CT/MRI. There will be regular weekly departmental educational meetings/presentations and MDT to present and interact with whole MDT.

Supervisor(s) for the placement	Dr J Chembala
Main duties of the placement	Junior doctors are expected to accompany consultants on ward rounds and carry out daily ward duties including venepuncture, cannulation, catheterisation, NG tube insertion, chasing and interpreting investigation results and clerking any new patient transfer to the unit. They are also expected to present cases and do presentations on weekly departmental educational meetings. Junior doctors will be allowed to attend certain number of specialised clinics and hyper acute stroke take.
