The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	<p>The General Paediatric Unit at UHNM is large and busy, consisting of 3 acute inpatient wards and a PICU.</p> <p>Within these wards we have medical and surgical day case facilities, sleep study beds and a 6 bedded HDU. We look after children with a variety of chronic and acute medical conditions and are well supported by paediatric subspecialties and PICU.</p> <p>Acute admissions are first seen in our CAU . In addition to this we also provide outpatients on RSH and County sites and outreach.</p>

Main duties of the placement	<p>Work will be both outpatients where you will join senior clinicians in clinic and acute. For acute work this will be split between the 3 inpatient wards and CAU (clerking, reviewing patients and seeing on ward round with the team).</p> <p>It will be varied to provide a full training experience and trainees will also join our regular departmental teaching program. F2 doctors will be on the same rota as ST1 and GPVTS doctors, getting the same training and support from our consultant body.</p>
