<b>The type of work to expect and learning opportunities</b>	Health Protection with focus on public health investigation & management of notifiable diseases and investigating outbreaks of infection.
<b>Where the placement is based</b>	Public Health England (PHE)- Health Protection Team

<b>Main duties of the placement</b>	Based with West Midlands North Health Protection Team
<b>Typical working pattern in this placement</b>	<p>The working hours are 9am-5pm and the placement is office based. This is primarily at the PHE office located at the St George's Hospital site in Stafford but does require weekly/bi-weekly attendance at PHE Centre office in Birmingham (close to Birmingham New Street station).</p> <p>This is a community placement and may occasionally require attendance at locations within Shropshire &amp; Staffordshire areas or hospital site visits. As such, in order to meet the travel requirements for this role, there is an expectation that you have your own transport or you will need to use public transport. This rotation also incorporates weekend shifts at either the Royal Stoke or County Hospital sites, covering medical specialities/A&amp;E.</p>
