Placement	FY2 Renal Medicine
The department	Renal Medicine
The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	Looking after patients with renal disease including acute kidney injury, chronic kidney disease, patients receving dialysis treatment (Haemodialysis/peritoneal dialysis) and kidney transplant patients. Educational opportunities: Gain experience in looking after patients with AKI and chronic kidney disease.
	Understand complications of haemodialysis and peritoneal dialysis. Gain experience in looking after patients with renal transplant and deal with complications following transplantation. Learn about the kidneys in multisystem disease eg SLE, vasculitis. Learn about looking after the patient with nephrotic syndrome and other glomerulonephritides. Learn to work in a multidisciplinary team environment. Weekly academic junior doctor teaching covering different renal topics. Weekly medical grand round. Weekly multidisciplinary nephro-radiology meeting to discuss interesting cases including ward cases Opportunity to attend monthly mortality meetings, histology, and departmental academic events. Opportunity to undertake Quality Improvement Projects in the Renal Department

Main duties of the placement	Looking after in-patients and admissions to the Renal Ward - Clerking, reviewing, delivering ward-based care, prescribing and discharge management, attending ward round under supervision of a registrar and/or consultant. Review patients on the dialysis unit/kidney unit under supervision of registrar and/or consultant
Typical working pattern in this placement	Days, long days, nights and weekends in a rotating shift
