Main duties of the placement	The FY1 will be based on the cardiology ward and be involved in clerking new patients and the on-going management of current patients. On this ward patients present with a full range of cardiac conditions including acute STEMI and Non-STEMI, arrhythmias and cardiac failure. In addition, the department is a busy TAVI centre and a tertiary referral centre for endocarditis. The FY1 will work in a team of 4 FY2 doctors, a CMT, a junior clinical fellow and a physicians' associate as well as the consultant and SpR of the week.
Typical working pattern in this placement	The working pattern will depend on the rota commitment. This may include out of hours. Clarification of this can be sought directly from the Trust
