Main duties of the placement	Ward management of emergency and rehab patients. Ward Rounds, frequency varies from ward to ward (moved around the wards each week) and involvement in the MDT meetings.
Typical working pattern in this placement	8.30am ward work, depending on each ward timetable - ward round and scheduled MDTs. On-call commitment 3.5 weeks of acute medicine at UHCW, involving early, late and night shifts. =4 weeks of on-call at Rugby 11am-9pm Mon - Thurs, fir 11am-7pm.
