<b>The type of work to expect and learning opportunities</b>	Weekly F1 teaching, acute medicine weekly teaching, Grand Round Lectures. This job is based on ward 3 which is an acute medical ward which currently also hosts some of the Rheumatology in patients. The trainee is encouraged to arrange attendance at Rheumatology Clinics
<b>Where the placement is based</b>	UNIVERSITY HOSPITALS COVENTRY AND WARWICKSHIRE NHS TRUST
<b>Supervisor(s) for the placement</b>	Dr Tanya Potter
<b>Main duties of the placement</b>	Ward care of patients on Ward 3 (general medical patients and Rheumatology patients) Ward Rounds with all consultants with patients on the ward. Clerking patients attending for day clinic therapy Acute medical block placement during rotation (~4weeks) spent in A+E/CDU
<b>Typical working pattern in this placement</b>	On-call commitment Acute medical block during placement ~4 weeks' worth in A+E/CDU, doing early/late/night shifts
