<b>Placement</b>	FY2 Oncology
<b>The department</b>	Oncology (Arden Cancer Centre)
<b>The type of work to expect and learning opportunities</b>	Care of acute oncology and elective oncology admissions. Ward based job.  Opportunity to attend outpatient clinics and radiotherapy sessions. Weekly ward based formal oncology teaching in addition to the protected weekly 2 hour FY2 teaching.
<b>Where the placement is based</b>	University Hospitals Coventry & Warwickshire
<b>Supervisor(s) for the placement</b>	
<b>Main duties of the placement</b>	FY2 Trainee will be working with core medical trainees and middle grades to gain experience in managing acute oncological emergencies and patients with treatment or disease complications. Trainee will be encouraged to attend outpatient clinics and gain insight about radiotherapy. There will be an opportunity to do audits and quality improvement projects.
<b>Typical working pattern in this placement</b>	Trainee will participate in the on-call rota.
<b>Employer information</b>	University Hospitals Coventry and Warwickshire NHS Trust is home to one of the largest teaching hospitals in England.
