<b>Placement</b>	FY2 Neurology
<b>The department</b>	Neurology
<b>The type of work to expect and learning opportunities</b>	This is a large Neurology and Neurosurgery centre with patients wide variety of conditions managed and referred in from a huge geographical area. There is a formal programme of clinical teaching for neurology CT's which the post holder will be encouraged to attend. Weekly dedicated two hour FY2 teaching.
<b>Where the placement is based</b>	University Hospital
<b>Supervisor(s) for the placement</b>	Dr Abdullah Shehu
<b>Main duties of the placement</b>	Care of patients with acute and chronic neurological problems, both inpatient and outpatient, multidisciplinary team working.
<b>Typical working pattern in this placement</b>	Full shift including twilight but not night duties
<b>Employer information</b>	UHCW Trust has PFI status and more than £400 million has been invested to build a new 1200 bed hospital on the Walsgrave Site. The main part of the new hospital opened in October 2006. All major specialties are represented. The Clinical Science Building opened on the Walsgrave site in November 2003. This is a state of the art postgraduate and undergraduate facility with an outstanding library and study area, and extensive high quality seminar and clinical teaching rooms.
