<b>Main duties of the placement</b>	Care of elective and emergency patients with gynaecological problems, and some experience on the labour ward. One Foundation Trainee would be on cover for O&G emergencies at any one time, (except overnight). These emergency sessions have 1 consultant and 2 registrars on-call for both obstetrics and gynaecology, and so are very fully supervised.
<b>Typical working pattern in this placement</b>	Twilight rota (not overnight) in gynaecology with the two GP trainees
