<b>Typical working pattern in this placement</b>	9am ward rounds every day. Ward jobs, Attending MDT, Reviewing pts on other wards if required; 1x session of 1 <sup>st</sup> on call covering A+E (2pm-9.30pm); 2 x session of 2 <sup>nd</sup> on-call covering the ward (5pm- 9.30pm); 12 nights-on-call during a 4 months rotation.

The majority of the Hospital is based in modern purpose built accommodation.</p> <p>Currently there are 410 beds divided between the major specialities.</p> <p>There is a new Postgraduate Medical Centre with excellent library facilities, a clinical skills training unit and a computer skills training centre.</p> <p>There is a very strong commitment to junior staff training.</p>
