Ward jobs, Attending MDT, Reviewing pts on other wards if required; 1x session of 1 <sup>st</sup> on call covering A+E (2pm-9.30pm); 2 x session of 2 <sup>nd</sup> on-call covering the ward (5pm- 9.30pm); 12 nights-on-call during a 4 months rotation.
