Placement	FY1 Cardiology
The department	Based in the Hereford County Hospital, the department has three consultant cardiologists who cover the Coronary Care Unit and Lugg Ward. The department has close links with University Hospital Birmingham.
The type of work to expect and learning	This post is an excellent opportunity to gain experience in Cardiology and General Medicine.
opportunities	There are opportunities to gain experience and access learning in: ward rounds, medical outpatients, weekly F1 teaching, weekly medical grand round, and handover.
	You will be working on the Lugg Ward and CCU, with usually around 26 patients, taking responsibility for history and knowledge of the patient and presenting them on ward rounds. You will also need to identify and escalate where necessary the deteriorating patient and clerking patients when on call. There is opportunity for regular bedside teaching relating to signs, conditions or investigations.
	This setting allows for the management and diagnosing of common conditions and will support learning in the following areas:
