Placement	FY1 Gastroenterology
The department	Based in the Hereford County Hospital the department comprises of three Consultant Gastroenterologists. Besides 15-25 inpatient beds, the department has weekly outpatient clinics and endoscopy lists.
The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	<p>This post is an excellent opportunity to gain experience in General Medicine. There are opportunities to gain experience and access learning in: ward rounds, medical outpatients, weekly F1 teaching, weekly medical grand round and handover.</p> <p>You will be working on the ward, with usually around 15-25 Gastro/General Medicine patients, taking responsibility for history and knowledge of the patient and presenting them on ward rounds. You will also need to identify and escalate where necessary the deteriorating patient and clerking patients when on call. There is opportunity for regular bedside teaching relating to signs, conditions or investigations.</p> <p>This setting allows for the management and diagnosing of common conditions and will support learning in the following areas:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Good clinical Professionalism • Good clinical care including history, examination, diagnosis and clinical decision making • Safe prescribing • Keeping Accurate Medical Records • Manage Time and clinical priorities effectively • Communicate effectively with patients, relatives and colleagues • Recognition and management of the acutely ill patient • Patients with long term conditions • Core procedures • Investigations • Interface with different specialities <p>Due to the nature of the working environment you will regularly receive ward based teaching which will include supervised learning events and gain feedback from higher grade doctors, consultants and clinicians working in this area. You will have the opportunity to work closely with a multi-disciplinary team to gain a full understanding of the patient's journey and your role within this.</p>

<p>Main duties of the placement</p>	<p>To work as part of a medical team responsible for the ongoing care of both general medical patients and patients with conditions related to gastroenterology.</p> <p>You will be expected to prepare patients for ward round, check and act on blood results, keep accurate records in notes; act on problems and issues that arise during the day; discuss care with patients and families; communicate with other team members including handover at evenings and weekends; write timely and accurate discharge summaries. You will be expected to attend weekly mandatory bleep free FY1 teaching.</p>
<p>Typical working pattern in this placement</p>	<p>Full shift rota which is EWTD compliant and includes late and night shifts.</p>
