Individual Placement Description – Wye Valley NHS Trust, Hereford County Hospital

Placement	FY1 Geriatric Medicine
The department	The department comprises of a 16 bedded assessment unit, which provides care specifically to older frail patients to help support their care and recovery. The department also provides medical input to medical outliers on the orthopaedic trauma ward. The usual patient numbers are 15-25 patients.
The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	This post is an excellent opportunity to gain experience in both General and Geriatric Medicine. There are opportunities to gain experience and access learning in: ward rounds, medical outpatients, weekly F1 teaching, weekly medical grand round and handover.
	You will be working in the assessment unit or on the medical ward, with usually around 16 older frail patients plus patients in general medicine, taking responsibility for history and knowledge of the patient and presenting them on ward rounds. You will also need to identify and escalate where necessary the deteriorating patient and clerking patients when on call. There is opportunity for regular bedside teaching relating to signs, conditions or investigations.
	This setting allows for the management and diagnosing of common conditions and will support learning in the following areas:

Typical working pattern in this placement	Full shift rota which is EWTD compliant and includes late and night shifts.
Employer information	The employer for this placement is Wye Valley NHS Trust, Hereford County Hospital.
