Individual Placement Description – Wye Valley NHS Trust, Hereford County Hospital

Placement	FY2 Intensive Care Medicine
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The department	Hereford County Hospital, Intensive Care Unit
The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	The post holder would gain experience in assessment, stabilisation and ongoing intensive care management of the acutely unwell patient from Medical, Surgical and Trauma perspectives. The intensive care unit has 6 level 2 and 3 (HDU and ITU) beds. Excellent levels of supervision and feedback are available. Further supervised exposure could be gained with the outreach and medical emergency response teams. The post holder would gain exposure to a variety of practical procedures and an understanding of organ support measures used on the ITU. For those who wish to be involved in Quality Improvement projects and Audit, this opportunity will be available. You will have the opportunity to attend weekly FY2 Core Curriculum Teaching.

Supervisor(s) for the placement	Educational Supervision - Dr J Connell if ITU is first placement of FY2 year. Clinical Supervision – Dr J Budd, Dr C Stevenson, Dr L Troth
Main duties of the placement	Attending morning handover and consultant led ward rounds on the ITU. Documentation and prescribing appropriate to training level. Admitting and discharging elective and emergency patients to and from the ITU with appropriate support and review. Attending medical emergency calls and ward referrals with appropriate senior support. Attendance at regular ITU quality improvement meetings.
Typical working pattern in this placement	This post holder will work weekend day shifts as part of the medical team on a 1 in 4 weekends, supporting the F1.
Employer information	 The employer for this placement is Wye Valley NHS Trust, Hereford County Hospital. Wye Valley NHS Trust is a provider of health care across rural Herefordshire bringing together acute and community services. The Trust runs the County Hospital based in the City of Hereford, along with 3 community hospitals in the small nearby towns of Ross-on-Wye, Leominster and Bromyard, we also operate a small 22 bedded unit for patients that are not acutely ill but may need nursing and therapy intervention following their acute illness.
