Individual Placement Description – Wye Valley NHS Trust, Hereford County Hospital

<b>Placement</b>	FY2 Obstetrics & Gynaecology
<b>The department</b>	<p>The department comprises of consultants who are obstetricians and gynaecologists and work closely with midwives in the maternity department. There are up to eight women's health beds on the second floor of the hospital next door to the maternity ward. The gynaecology clinics take place on the same floor and are shared with the antenatal clinics and the pregnancy scanning department. Patients who are undergoing day case surgery are admitted to the day case ward on the ground floor.</p> <p>There are five consultants in this specialty. Much of the work is general Gynaecology but specialist clinics are held in the following areas: Colposcopy, Infertility, Endometrial assessment clinics, Gynaecology therapy and investigation (GTI), Termination of pregnancy, Urodynamics, Joint Gynaecology Cancer clinic.</p>
