On-site PPCI, stroke thrombolysis, and vascular surgery. Designated Trauma Unit. 8 bedded Clinical Decisions Unit for stays of up to 24 hours.</p> <p>Seeing all types of ED attenders (majors, minors, resus, paed) under the direct 24hr supervision of middle grade EM doctor or consultants.</p> <p>Responsible for the initial assessment of ED attenders, together with formulation of management plans and implementation of urgent treatment in a friendly progressive department with a strong interest in post graduate education.</p> <p>Protected teaching time – EM (Thursday 11:00-13:30) FY2 (Wednesday 13-15:00). Bespoke ED induction programme.</p>
