The department	General Practice
The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	A typical week would be modelled as follows: 7-8 sessions clinical, 1 session academic/private study, 1 session attendance at F2 teaching. There would be also ample time for ongoing clinical/educational supervision. This may include the review of current guidelines (local and NICE), feedback on consultations and opportunities to sit in chronic disease clinics (CHD, Asthma, COPD, Diabetes etc). As well as plentiful clinical learning opportunities (both of an acute and chronic nature), improve your team-working skills as part of the wider team, which may include District Nurses and the Palliative Care Team. An excellent environment to undertake an audit and to improve the life skills of compassion, empathy, organisation, confidence, negotiation, time-management and resilience.
Where the placement is based	Worcestershire
Supervisor(s) for the placement	GP trainer in GP Practice or Foundation Year Supervisor.
Main duties of the placement	Working alongside a GP and the rest of the Primary Care Health Team. Initially, consultations will be observed, but then independent, but all reviewed by an experienced GP. Other responsibilites may include vetted home visits, reviewing results, involvement with Medicines Management (prescribing), making appropriate referrals and reviewing letters received from the hospital.
