The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	Work: General acute paediatrics and neonatal medicine ward working including daily ward rounds on paediatric ward and neonatal unit, attending deliveries, postnatal checks and attending outpatient clinics. Seeing emergency admissions including acutely ill patients with close supervision. Learning opportunities: Once weekly SHO teaching, once weekly departmental teaching (includes safeguarding peer review, morbidity and mortality meetings and audit) plus monthly X-ray.

Main duties of the placement	Supervised clerking of paediatric patients and developing management plans, ward work, assisting on ward rounds. Practical procedures with support such as venepuncture, inserting cannulas, assisting with lumbar punctures. Completing baby checks. Attending high risk deliveries, with supervision and training. Attending outpatient clinics as learning opportunities.
