Supervisor(s) for the placement	Consultant Urologist
Main duties of the placement	As the majority of our FY2 doctors will have not worked in a Urology department before their learning objectives and duties may overlap those of FY1 colleagues. However our FY2 doctors will already have broad clinical experience from their previous year. We would expect the FY2's to support their FY1 colleagues whilst also looking to consolidate generic clinical skills.
